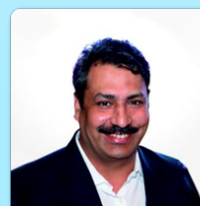

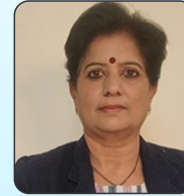

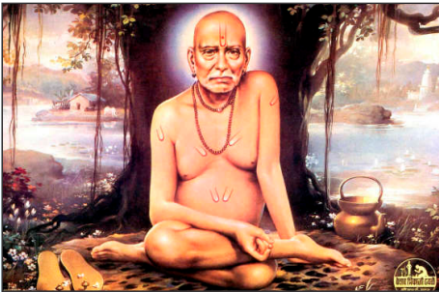

ABOUT SOLAPUR



Shree Siddheshwar Mandir, Solapur

The temple is dedicated to Siddheshwar, a twelfth-century devotee of Shiva who is considered a god in the Lingayat faith. Siddheshwar is also revered as the gramadevat (village deity) of Solapur. The temple marks the site where Siddheshwar attained samadhi (spiritual liberation), and a marble samadhi exists at the center of the temple today. The best time to visit the temple is during the Makar Sankranti festival in mid-January when a grand celebration takes place over three days. The Gadda Yatra, a local fair, is arranged for fifteen days in the vicinity of the temple. On Makarsankrant, there is annual pilgrimage called 'Gadda,' and a procession called the 'Procession of Kathis' is conducted at the temple. The temple is attended by members of the Veerashaiva community.



Shree Swami Samarth Mandir, Akkalkot

Shri Swami Samarth lived during nineteenth century, from 1858 to 1878. He is considered an incarnation of Lord Dattatreya within the Dattatreya Tradition. Swami Samarth is often referred to as Akkalkot Maharaj due to his association with the town of Akkalkot in Maharashtra. Swami Samarth's teachings emphasize compassion, self-realization, and service to humanity. His divine presence is felt in the temple premises, where devotees experience a spiritually charged atmosphere. From Swami Samarth Annachattra Mandal Trust thousands of devotees receive the mahaprasad (blessed food) daily from this temple.



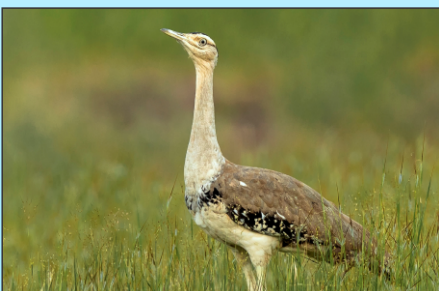
Shree Vitthal Mandir, Pandharpur

Shri Vitthal Rukmini Mandir, also known as the Vithoba Temple, is a revered Hindu temple located in Pandharpur, Maharashtra. Devotees visit this temple to worship Vithoba, a form of Lord Vishnu or Lord Krishna, along with his consort Rukmini. Here are some key points about this sacred temple. The temple is dedicated to Lord Vitthala (Vithoba) and Mata Rukmini. It is one of the most visited pilgrimage sites in Maharashtra, drawing devotees seeking blessings and spiritual solace. On this ghat stands the temple of Bhakta Pundalika, where the legendary story of Krishna meeting his disciple Bhakta Pundalik unfolds. Pundalika offered a brick (called 'vit' in Marathi) to Krishna, who stood on it while waiting for Pundalika to attend to his parents.



Dr. Dwarkanath Kotnis Smarak, Solapur

Dr. Dwarkanath Shantaram Kotnis, born in 1910 in Solapur, Maharashtra, was a remarkable Indian physician whose selfless service left an indelible mark on Sino-Indian friendship. Let's delve into his inspiring story. In 1938, during the Second Sino-Japanese War, the communist General Zhu De requested Jawaharlal Nehru to send physicians to China. Dr. Kotnis volunteered and joined the Indian Medical Mission Team along with four other doctors. Their mission was a gesture of solidarity between two nations striving for freedom. Dr. Kotnis worked tirelessly on the front lines, providing medical aid to the Chinese people.



Great Indian Bustard Sanctuary

This sanctuary is famous for the rare bird species, the Great Indian Bustard (also known as Maldhok). Birdwatchers and nature enthusiasts can explore the sanctuary's diverse ecosystem and observe these magnificent birds in their natural habitat.

Shri Sangmeshwar Temple, Hattarsang Kudal

Hattarsang Kudal, situated in the Solapur district of Maharashtra, holds hidden treasures in the form of ancient temples. Let me share some insights about these remarkable temples. The Shri Sangmeshwar Temple is one of the oldest temples in Solapur's history. Located at the confluence (sangam) of the Bhima and Sina Rivers, it offers a serene and scenic setting. The temple houses a Bahumukhi Shivalingam, an extraordinary lingam with 359 faces, representing various deities.

The NRCP is dedicated to strengthening research and development infrastructure for pomegranate crop. It aims to fulfill the growing demand for pomegranates in both domestic and export markets by tapping into the immense production potential in India. The NRCP is the sole institute in the world solely dedicated to research on pomegranates. The NRCP plays a crucial role in advancing pomegranate cultivation and quality production.



Solapur Bhuikot Fort, Solapur

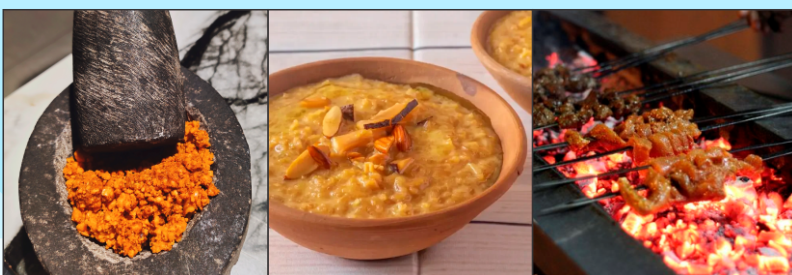
Solapur Fort, also known as Bhuikot Killa, is a historical fortification located in Solapur. **Historical Significance:** The fort dates back to the 14th century and was built by the Bahmani dynasty. It has witnessed numerous historical events and has been under the control of various dynasties, including the Mughals and Marathas. The fort features double fortification and is known for its Bahmani era construction style. It has two gates, the North gate and Mahakali gate, and houses a Shani temple, a ruined Shiva temple with an underground Shiva Linga, and a Mahakaleshwar temple. The fort is not only an ancient Muslim fort but also one of the ancient historical and religious places in Maharashtra. It is associated with the marriage of Lord Siddheshwar, an important cultural event in the city.



Solapuri Chaddar & Terry Towels.

A Solapuri chaddar (also known as a Solapur blanket) is a cotton blanket made in Solapur. These blankets are popular in India where they are manufactured, previously by handloom but now by Jacquard machines. They are known for their unique design and durability. Geographical Indication (GI) status has been granted to Solapuri chaddars, recognizing their cultural and historical significance. Solapur Terry Towels are made from cotton yarn. These towels have been protected under the Geographical Indication (GI) act. Solapur Terry Towels have unique designs and are in demand globally. Solapur Terry Towels are excellent for water absorption. This textile industry provides livelihood assistance to nearly 200,000 people.

Solapur Food Culture

Sikh Kabab - A popular non-vegetarian delicacy in Solapur, known for its rich flavors and succulent texture. These kababs are typically made with minced meat, seasoned with a blend of spices, and grilled on coal with skewers.
